The new academic year began with the announcement of new Post Graduate Diploma Courses. 



The Participants (numbering 145) included staff and students from the P G departments of School of Sciences, from various colleges of Gujarat University and from other University (Ganpat University, Mehsana). The invited speaker, Dr. Sanjeev Kumar from IVRI (Indian Vegetable Research Institute), Varanasi gave lucid lectures on Transformation, Transgenics and Applications of Biotechnology along with appropriate demonstrations. Mr. Naimesh Patel demonstrated the testing of cotton seeds for BT gene by ELISA technique. The best two participants were given prizes and all participants received certificates and photocopied lecture notes.

The staff and students (numbering 18) of the department actively participated in the State Level Seminar on Reproductive Biology of Angiosperms at Talod. Prof. Y. T.
