## COOPERATION AGREEMENT

dated 29th April 2017 between

University of Life Sciences in Lublin, Poland, represented by Prof. Dr hab. Zbigniew Grądzki Vice-Rector for Science, Implementation and International Cooperation and

Dr P. M. Patel

Registrar (I/C), Gujarat University, Ahmedabad, Gujarat, India represented by Dr PD Gupta Adjunct Professor, School of Sciences, Gujarat University, Ahmedabad, Gujarat, India

§1

The both parties shall cooperate in the field of scientific research and teaching.

§2

- 1. The both parties declare their readiness to cooperate in the following areas:
- 1) conducting joint research consistent with the objectives pursued by both parties,
  - 2) conducting joint research projects,
  - 3) organization of joint scientific meetings and scientific consultations,
  - 4) exchange of students and teaching staff.
  - 5) establishing the program of internship (students exchange).
- 2. Terms and conditions referred to in paragraph 1 shall be determined separately each time by mutual consultations and arrangements of the paraes.

§3

1. The agreement does not bear any financial liabilities of either party. The method of financing projects implemented under this agreement shall be determined in each case by negotiation and shall depend on available funds.

2. In order to implement the agreement, the parties can use the financial resources at each party disposal, and other resources according to each country's regulations.

§4

- 1. The both parties undertake to respect the principles of full confidentiality of the transmitted information and materials.
- 2. Employment of the joint research results shall be subjected to the rules existing

in each country.

- 1. Any changes and supplements to the agreement must be made in writing in order to be valid.
- 2. The issues not regulated in this agreement the parties shall resolve with rules existing in cultural and scientific cooperation between the two countries.

§6

1. The Agreement is concluded for a period of three (3) years.

2. If none of the parties concerned to terminate the agreement it automatically goes to the next three (3) years.

3. The parties may terminate this cooperation agreement by giving ninety (90) days written notice.

§7

Agreement is made in two copies in English, two copies in Russian and two copies in Polish, and the contents of both language versions are identical.

The cooperation agreement enters into efficiency on date of its signature by both contracting parties.
