Step1. Application Forms Submission

Submit the listed application documents (1-1. to 1-12.) to the exchange coordinator at your institution, NOT DIRECTLY to OIDAI. Please note that THE DEADLINE for submission from the coordinator to OIDAI is April 30, and thus contact the coordinator soon if interested.

Visa Application (Certificate of Eligibility)

Based on the submitted application, OIDAI will apply your Certificate of Eligibility (COE) at the Japanese immigration office.

Once the COE is issued by the Japanese immigration bureau, we will send it to your home institution by trackable mailing method like DHL or EMS. Then, receive the original documents including COE from your home institution, and apply for a visa at the nearest Japanese embassy/consulate with the following documents.

- 1. Valid passport
- 2. One visa application form, completed and signed
- 3. One passport-sized photograph (taken within last 6 months)
- 4. Original COE
- One photocopy of COE

+++Important+++

We do not allow exchange students to do any other activities such as sightseeing in Japan before and after the period of study at OIDAI on the student visa. If you want to stay longer in Japan before or after the exchange period, then please consult to the Embassy/Consulate of Japan nearby on the visa arrangement.

遵守事項 Guidelines

- 1. 日本政府が定める対策の順守 Compliance with Respect to Government Measures.
- (1)日本政府が施行する対策に従うこと。その際、対策の必要に応じて大学が学外機関と 留学生に関する情報を共有することについて同意すること。 International students must follow the border control measures enforced by the Japanese government. In doing so, they should agree that the university will share information on international students with external organizations as necessary for countermeasures.
- (2) 留学生は、大学へ提出した情報や旅程に変更が生じた場合には、遅滞なく大学へ共有すること。
 International students should share any changes in the information or itinerary submitted to the University without delay.
- (3)留学生は、大学から要請があった場合は、大学の指示に従い、感染及びその拡大防止に 努めること。 International students, if required by the University, should follow the instructions of the University to prevent infection and its spread.
- (4)留学生は、検疫法、感染症の予防及び感染症の患者に対する医療に関する法律、出入国管理及び難民認定法等の水際制度関連法令を遵守すること。 International students must comply with the laws and regulations related to the New Border measures, including the Quarantine Law, the Law Concerning Prevention of Infectious Diseases and Medical Care for Infectious Patients, and the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act.
- (5) 留学生は、上記の誓約に違反した場合又は入国時の検疫の際に誓約する誓約書の内容に違反した場合(いずれも不実の記載があった場合を含む。)には、政府より在留資格の取消しや大学より受入れ中止などの判断があり、これに従うこと。
 If an international student violates the above pledge or violates the contents of the

written pledge that is pledged at the time of quarantine at the time of entry (including cases of misrepresentation in either case), the international student shall be subject to the following. In such cases, the government may revoke the student's status of residence, or the university may suspend the student's enrollment, and the student must comply with the decision.

2 . その他順守事項 Other Compliance

International students are required to prepare a cell phone number and LINE or WeChat account in their home country to contact the staff of the Division of International Cooperation and Planning and to actually try to contact them.

International students, if required by the University, must abide by the standards of conduct based on the prevention of the spread of the COVID-19, which are independently established by the University.
