




Programme schedule showing the lecture of Prof. V.K.Jain and Prof. V.K.Jain with the chairperson of the session: Mr. Larry A. Mann

Poster Session: Nanoparticle synthesis and application

Relevant Abstract: Synthesis of highly stable, water dispersible fluorescent silver nanoparticles have been reported using tetramethoxy resorcinarene tetra-hydrazide (TMRTH) as a reducing as well as a stabilizing agent. TMRTH-AgNPs are found to be highly stable for 120 days for varied pH and temperature. Fluorescence studies reveal TMRTH-AgNPs as turn-off fluorescent sensor for Cr(III) with a detection limit of 1 mM to 1 μM. TMRTH-AgNPs also exhibit good antimicrobial activity.

Relevant Abstract: A simple one-pot chemical reduction method using novel, tetrahydrazide derivative of calix[4]pyrrole (CPTH) for the preparation of small sized palladium nanoparticles (CPTH-PdNPs) is described in this work. This novel nanocatalyst showed high catalytic performance for Mizoroki-Heck coupling reactions and could be reused five times without considerable loss in its catalytic activity. Also, the antibacterial nature of the nanoparticles suggests its utility in biological fields. We are further looking forward to explore this nanocatalyst in different reactions and their environmental applications.

The inauguration ceremony included University song of Gujarat University, Lightening of the lamp and welcome of the guests with flowers and momentum. Dr. A. U. Mankad.


