3. BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

Ocean plays very important role in linkage to the carbon cycle of the planet earth. There are both the natural and anthropogenic sources which regulate the carbon cycle categorized as sources and sinks. The biological pump is one of the important mechanism for the carbon sequestration to the deep ocean. Phytoplankton, the recognized marine primary producers utilize new and recycled nutrients to convert the dissolved inorganic carbon to particulate organic carbon (POC) [Eppley and Peterson, 1979; Longhurst and Harrison, 1989]. A fraction of POC is then exported vertically to deep waters by various mechanisms as consumption by zooplankton and fish, excretion of fecal pellets and by Particle aggregation and sinking.


