
Shaping Tomorrow's Leaders Through Knowledge & Action




National Level Workshop on Effective Visualization using Power Bl

SUMMER INTERNSHIP 2025

Department of Psychology, Gujarat University

Like every year, the Department of Psychology, Gujarat University, successfully organized a Clinical Internship Program for students of M.A. Clinical Psychology at the Hospital for Mental Health, Ahmedabad, during the summer break from 19th May to 2nd July 2025. This internship forms an integral part of the students' academic training and aims to bridge the gap between theoretical learning and real-world clinical application.

The students were divided into four batches and rotated through the following key units:

- In-Patient Ward (IPD)
- Out-Patient Ward (OPD)
- Occupational Therapy (OT)
 Unit
- Workshop

Under the supervision of experienced clinical staff, the students had the opportunity to observe and participate in a wide range of diagnostic and therapeutic activities. They were exposed to various psychiatric cases and introduced to essential clinical procedures, including case history taking, assessment tools, treatment planning, and intervention strategies commonly used in professional practice.



Each unit provided unique and focused learning experiences:

- In-Patient Ward (IPD): Students observed individuals with acute psychiatric conditions, participated in case discussions, and learned about admission processes, medication adherence, and long-term patient care.
- Out-Patient Ward (OPD): This unit enabled students to witness intake interviews, clinical assessments, diagnostic procedures, and follow-up consultations, offering insight into short-term and community-based mental health care.
- Occupational Therapy (OT) Unit: Students interacted with children having intellectual disabilities and developmental issues, gaining an understanding of structured therapeutic activities designed to enhance motor coordination, behavior regulation, social interaction, and cognitive functioning.
- Workshop: Here, students engaged with long-term psychiatric patients involved in vocational rehabilitation activities, observing the psychosocial aspects of recovery and the importance of structured engagement in improving quality of life.

Throughout the program, students maintained daily clinical logs, participated in reflective discussions, and received constructive feedback from both hospital and departmental supervisors. The internship helped students deepen their understanding of mental health conditions, clinical ethics, therapeutic techniques, patient interaction, and the multidisciplinary approach essential to effective mental health care.

This internship proved to be an enriching and transformative experience. It empowered students to apply academic concepts in clinical settings, enhanced their professional competence, and fostered a deeper appreciation for the responsibilities of working in the field of clinical psychology.
