Climate Crisis and Reforms

In recent news from August and September 2025, both Uttarakhand and Punjab have experienced severe weather events, with Uttarakhand suffering from cloudbursts and flash floods, and Punjab dealing with widespread riverine floods. The Uttarakhand cloudburst in Dehradun led to fatalities, property damage, and stranded individuals, while the Punjab floods resulted in significant loss of life, widespread displacement, damaged infrastructure, and substantial crop damage.

The climate crisis is one of the most urgent and complex challenges of our time. Human beings are sensitive to environmental drivers such as rising temperatures and altered precipitation patterns, with far-reaching consequences for the health of crops, livestock, and human populations. Climate change can also disrupt biogeochemical cycles, thereby altering feedbacks that influence Earth system processes. Realizing this coordinated action and shared goals across societies, stakeholders, sectors, and borders is required.

It is time to invest in more effective communication strategies to combat this problem prioritize storytelling, advocacy, and media engagement. By partnering with professional communicators, developing accessible and engaging content, and launching global outreach campaigns, community can help climate conversation. Real-world demonstration projects would be of great help and candeliver measurable ecological and economic outcomes, foster local engagement and trust, and attract interest from funders, policymakers, and industry leaders.














GUJARAT UNIVERSITY SHINES WITH

PROF MEENU SARAF, VISITING SCIENTIST AT DSMZ, GERMANY

Professor (Dr) Meenu Saraf, Director School of Sciences and HOD of Department of Microbiology and Biotechnology, Gujarat University, Ahmedabad. She is a WISER Awardee from Indo German Science and Technology Centre, DST, Govt. Of India (2022). Prof Saraf got the opportunity to carry out her research work on a collaborative project titled- "Nutrient Dynamics and Functional Aspects of Microbial Diversity in saline Soils". As a part of her grant she visited Germany as Visiting Scientist at Leibniz Institute DSMZ-German Collection of Microorganisms and Cell Cultures, Braunschweig for four weeks (June - July 2025). Her host is Prof. Dr. Jörg Overmann, Director at DSMZ. The research study analyzed microbial communities in saline and non-saline soils, focusing on the relationship between culturable and unculturable diversity for Glycine max and Sorghum.

In last week of the visit Prof Saraf visited the lab of Prof. Dr. Michael Schloter, Director, Research Unit Comparative Microbiome Analysis and Chair of Environmental Microbiology at Technical University of Munich.






PARIKSHA PE CHARCHA




